Miss Rodeo North Dakota State Fair Pageant 2011 Friday, July 23, 2010

RULES:

1. Each contestant must fill out application and pay the \$75.00 entry fee. Contestant may find up to 4 sponsors to help with entry fee.
2. Application must be postmarked/sent by July 9, 2010.
3. A 5" x 7" or smaller head shot photo with a cowboy hat must be sent with application.
4. Contestants must provide a short one page biography to be used during the modeling portion of the pageant.
5. Contestant must be between the ages of 18 and 23 as of July 23, 2010.
6. Contestant cannot be a current titleholder from another pageant or rodeo.
7. Contestant cannot have been or are married and/or pregnant and cannot be living with a man other than a relative.
8. Each contestant is responsible to bring her own horse for horsemanship competition. A flag boot is required for the flag run portion for the competition. If stalling is needed, arrangements need to be made by the contestant. Stall can be reserved through the State Fair office (857-7620).
9. Contestants should wear appropriate clothing for the interview, modeling and speech portions. The horsemanship portion requires denim jeans by Wrangler (in any color) to be worn. Cowboy hats, belts and western boots should be worn at all times during competition.
10. Split reins must be used during the horsemanship competition. No spurs will be allowed.
11. The contestants selected by the panel of judges as the new Miss Rodeo North Dakota State Fair will reign for one complete year (October 2011-October 2012). She will compete in the Miss Rodeo North Dakota pageant held during the Y's Men's PRCA Rodeo in October of 2011 in Minot.
12. The 2011 Miss Rodeo North Dakota State Fair will represent the State Fair at the following rodeos: 2011 & 2012 State Fair rodeos, 2011 NDRA Finals, Roughrider Rodeo Assn Finals, ND Winter Show and the NPRA Finals. She must attend the 2011 Miss Rodeo ND Pageant and Y's Men's PRCA Rodeo. Other events and appearances will come about and this young lady should be flexible to these arrangements.
13. The 2011 Miss Rodeo North Dakota State Fair Queen will conduct herself in a manner that promotes the N. D. State Fair, the sport of rodeo in North Dakota and appear professional and courteous at all times while representing her title.
